

# CAMP LOTUS RIVER GUIDE PROCEDURES

*EVERY GUIDE USING CAMP LOTUS MUST RECEIVE, AND READ, A COPY OF THIS SHEET!*

## WHAT USE IS CHARGED FOR

ALL put-ins, take-outs, lunch and camping must be reported to us. If your company is covering you, then report it to us daily as a charge. If not, please pay us DAILY (on arrival or first thing in the morning) for your personal use of Camp Lotus, and make sure all cars - yours and your customers - have parking tags if they are going to be here after 12:00 noon.

## USE REPORTING

Each day one person from your company or group must report all charged use to the store or to the person doing rounds. Give them all your numbers for the day, and night before, using our "Outfitter Reporting Slips". This will include:

- 1) The number of people camping the night before. As far as possible include guides and passengers that paid us directly, so we can credit your company appropriately for put-ins and takeouts covered by camping.
- 2) The number of put-ins, take-outs, and/or lunch users for that day.
- 3) Make sure every car that will be parked after 12:00 noon has a tag, including cars arriving in the morning. Camp Lotus will count the number of cars your company has parked at 1:00 pm. Cars not charged to your company must be paid for at the beginning of the day.

## PARKING & CHECK-OUT

Please check-out of your site (and ask that your passengers do) before you go on the river in the morning, unless you all have a reservation for the following night in the same site. ALL vehicles, tents, and personal gear must be out by check-out (12:00 noon). Please move cars to group parking lot so campers who have booked sites can move into them by check-in at 2:00 pm.

## GARBAGE, LITTER & WASTEWATER

- 1) Burn burnables only in your firepit. (NOT plastic OR Cardboard!)
- 2) Recycle all recyclables (including cardboard) in blue recycle bins.
- 3) If you generate a lot of organic, non meat garbage talk to us about using it to feed our worms and build our soil!
- 4) Please dispose of your grey water in the drains under our faucets. If they are not draining let us know!
- 5) Please remind your campers, as often as necessary, to put all small pieces of paper, cigarette butts, bottle caps, etc. in the garbage cans. Please help us keep Camp Lotus a pretty place by picking up these items when you see them. Thankyou!

## RIVER USE

Camp Lotus has no lifeguard. The river bottom is uneven, with steep drop-offs, cold water, unpredictable currents and submerged hazards. Anyone entering the water does so at their own risk. Please inform your passengers of this.

## NOISE

Guides are responsible for containing noise in their campsite. If you reserve a site we expect you to have personnel with your clients that will enforce, if necessary, our quiet hours. They are from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Camp Lotus is a place to have fun, but it is definitely not a party place.

Getting a river trip together can be noisy and rowdy. Please be considerate of people who are trying to have a peaceful time - and respect everyone's space. Also watch out for people, especially small kids, when moving equipment to and from the river.

## NO DOGS!

DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT CAMP LOTUS, EXCEPT FOR GUIDE DOGS. PLEASE DO NOT ASK FOR EXCEPTIONS. THERE WILL BE NONE! Please advise anyone who plans to come to Camp Lotus to leave their pets AT HOME, and please don't bring your dog to the camp.
